Rent From the Band: \$100 annual donation due at the beginning of the school year (August/September) and at the end of the school year for use over the summer and following school year (May/June)

Purchasing an Instrument: Purchasing an instrument from a retail store or online store should only be done once the family knows that the student is dedicated and loves making music. Decisions on what instrument to purchase should be discussed with the band director and/or private instrument teacher.
